

The sliding doors are galvanized as standard. On request, these surfaces are also available primer-coated in RAL 9002 as well as in various other colours based on RAL.










Recess flaps for the lintel area


The track cladding is attached horizontally in the lintel area. The track recess flap is closed manually and the opening mechanism is automatically activated by a control.






Ceiling suspension fitting (only for parking area)
